The Talbot County Board of Commissioners held a called meeting on Tuesday, December 11, 2012 at 6:00 PM. The meeting was held at the County Commission Office located at 74 West Monroe Street, Talbotton, Georgia.

Those in attendance were, Chairman Montgomery, Vice Chairman Holmes, Commissioners, Robert Lanier, Ken Chapman, County Attorney, Andrew Dodgen, County Manager and the County Clerk/Assistant County Manager.

Chairman Montgomery called the meeting to order.

The first item up for discussion was an invoice for inmate medical care, in the amount of \$30,213.47 from Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia (BCBSGA).

The Board directed the County Manger to contact a representative at BCBSGA to see if they would consider negotiating the cost of the invoice for the inmate medical care.

The next items up for discussion were two invoices totaling \$2,449.20 from the Talbot County Board of Education for Talbot County Recreation Transportation.

The Board directed the County Manager to contact the School Superintendent to discuss the charges.

Commissioner Chapman made a motion for the Board to go into Executive Session at 6:45 p.m. to discuss possible litigation. Vice Chairman Holmes seconded the motion. The vote passed 4-0-0.

Chairman Montgomery called the regular meeting back to order at 7:05 p.m.

No decisions were made in Executive Session.

Hiring Michael Smith at \$100.00 per month to do custodial/maintenance work at the park in the Geneva/Box Springs area was discussed with the Commissioners.

Following the discussion, Commissioner Chapman made a motion, and Commissioner Lanier seconded, for the Board to approve the request to hire Michael Smith to do custodial/maintenance work at the park in the Geneva/Box Springs area. The vote passed 3-0-0.

Vice Chairman Holmes left during Executive Session.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
