The Talbot County Board of Commissioners held a Called Meeting/Workshop on Wednesday, November 1, 2017 at 1:00 pm, at the County Commission Office, located at 74 West Monroe Street, Talbotton, Georgia 31827. Chair Sher'Londa Walker, Commissioners Ken Chapman, Raines Jordan, Freeman Montgomery, and the County Manager, Carol Ison were present. The Road Superintendent Mike Smith was also in attendance.

Chair Walker called the meeting to order.

The first order of business was the 2018 Proposed Road Paving Project. David Millen and Clayton Moore, representing Vaughn and Melton Consulting Engineers, Inc. were present to offer their services.

Using the Road Pavement Assessment Guide, provided by the engineers, the Board chose the roads from each of their districts that rated below 64, to include in the proposed project. The list of roads are as follows:

The Road Department will perform the necessary patching on George Smith Road.

Vaughn and Melton Consulting Engineers Inc. will proceed with preparing an estimate for the proposed project.

The Board agreed to include the following list of roads for the 2018 Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant (LMIG);

- Carter Loop
- George Smith (Patching)
- Tax
- Neal
- North Poplar Trace

Vaughn and Melton Consulting Engineers Inc. will provide estimates and have them ready to present at the December Meeting.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion, Commissioner Chapman seconded, for the Board to approve Robinson Paving Co. to proceed with the additional patching on Dennis Creek Road. Unused funds, in the amount of \$12,555.46 from the 2016 LMIG Project, will be used to fund the project. There may be some additional cost for traffic control. Vaughn and Melton Consulting Engineers Inc. will oversee the project. The vote passed 4-0-0.

Commissioner Chapman made a motion, Commissioner Jordan seconded, for the Board to approve the engineering services from Vaughn and Melton Consulting Engineers Inc., for the 2017 LMIG Off-System Safety Project. The vote passed 4-0-0.

Vaughn and Melton Consulting Engineers Inc. will provide the necessary documents at the December meeting.

There being no further business, Commissioner Montgomery made a motion to for the meeting to adjourn. Commissioner Chapman seconded the motion. The vote passed 4-0-0.
