The Talbot County Board of Commissioners held a Called Meeting Wednesday, January 13, 2020, at 3:00 pm, at the Talbot County Board of Commissioners Office, located at 74 West Monroe Street, Talbotton, Georgia.

Chairperson Sher'Londa Walker, Vice Chairman Franklin Holmes, Commissioners Ken Chapman and Robert Lanier were in attendance. Also, in attendance was the County Attorney, Edward Davis, County Manager, Carol Ison and Deputy County Clerk, Schequlia Willis. Commissioner Montgomery was unable to attend.

Chair Walker called the meeting to order.

The meeting was held to discuss the Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST) projects for the County and municipalities.

Following a lengthy discussion with representatives from the City of Talbotton and City of Woodland, an agreement was reached to distribute the SPLOST funds based on municipal population and enter into an Intergovernmental agreement.

The Board agreed to distribute the anticipated SPLOST funding as follows: 35% Roads and Bridges, 30% Community Building, 20% Public Safety, and 15% to be disbursed to the municipalities based on population.

The county attorney will draft the Intergovernmental Agreements and have ready to present at the February 3, 2020 board meeting.

There being no further business, Vice Chairman Holmes made a motion for the meeting to adjourn. Commissioner Lanier seconded the motion. The vote passed 4-0-0.
