The Talbot County Board of Commissioners held a Called Meeting on Friday, October 16, 2020 at 10:00 a.m., at the County Commission Office, located at 74 West Monroe Street, Talbotton, Georgia 31827. Chair Sher'Londa Walker, Vice Chairman Franklin Holmes, Commissioners Ken Chapman, and Freeman Montgomery were present. The County Attorney, Edward Davis and County Manager, Carol Ison were also in attendance. Commissioner Montgomery arrived a few minutes late.

Chair Walker called the meeting to order.

Prior to discussing the contract with Dependable Waste Services, Inc., the County Attorney advised the board to convene in Executive Session.

Vice Chairman Holmes made a motion to go into Executive Session at 10:11 a.m., Commissioner Chapman seconded the motion. The vote passed 3-0-0.

Commissioner Montgomery arrived during executive session.

Chair Walker called the meeting back to order at 10:32 a.m.

No decisions were made in executive session.

Following discussion of the Waste Hauling Service contract with Doug Matthews, representing Dependable Waste Services, Commissioner Chapman made a motion to continue operating under the current contract for ninety (90) days and to pay the appropriate Consumer Price Index (CPI) per the contract. The motion is to include assigning the contract to Best Way Specialties, a subsidiary account of Dependable Waste Services, Inc. Commissioner Montgomery seconded the motion. The vote passed 4-0-0.

The price will increase to \$11.41 per household, per month.

The County Manager was directed to proceed with a Request for Proposal (RFP) for the Waste Hauling Services.

There being no further business, Vice Chairman Holmes made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Chair Walker seconded the motion. The vote passed 4-0-0.
