August 9, 2021

The Talbot County Board of Commissioners held a Called Meeting on Monday, August 9, 2021 at 5:00 p.m., at the County Commission Office, located at 74 West Monroe Street, Talbotton, Georgia 31827. Chair Sher'Londa Walker, Vice Chairman Franklin Holmes and Commissioner Larry Sparks were present. Also in attendance were County Manager, Carol Ison, Assistant County Manager, Ronnie Hendricks, and County Clerk, Jona Gibson.

Chair Walker called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. Commissioner Sparks arrived shortly after meeting was called to order.

Also in attendance were Tax Commissioner, Jamie Huff, and Lorraine Bishop. They shared concerns with the Board regarding their proposed office move to a permanent location. Tax Commissioner Huff discussed with the Board that he did not believe the Board of Commissioners Office would meet the needs of his office. His proposal was to go back to the original plan he submitted that would require a renovation to the old office on Jefferson Street. After a lengthy discussion, the Commissioners asked Assistant County Manager Hendricks to get a plan and bids to renovate the office on Jefferson Street. Assistant County Manager Hendricks said that he should be able to provide this by the October Board Meeting.

The County Manager presented a draft of the FYE 2022 Proposed Budget. After discussion, Vice Chair Holmes made a motion to accept budget as presented and to give County Manager Ison permission to go ahead with advertisement of the Proposed Budget. A Public Hearing will be scheduled for August 19, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. at the County Commission Office. Chair Walker seconded. The vote passed 3-0-0.

There being no further business, Vice Chair Holmes made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Sparks seconded. The vote passed 3-0-0.
