The Talbot County Board of Commissioners held a Called Meeting on Tuesday, December 13, 2022, at 9:00 a.m., at the County Commission Office, located at 35 West Madison Street, Talbotton, Georgia 31827. Chair Sher'Londa Walker, Vice Chair, Franklin Holmes, and Commissioner Larry Sparks were present. County Manager, Carol Ison and Assistant County Manager, Ronnie Hendricks were also in attendance.

Chair Walker called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the FYE 2023 Local Maintenance Improvement Grant (LMIG) project.

Following a brief discussion, Vice Chair Holmes made a motion to approve Teal Road for the 2023 LMIG project. Commissioner Sparks seconded the motion. Any revenue shortfall will be funded with SPLOST funds divided between district 3 and district 5. The vote passed 3-0-0.

Road Superintendent, Peter Nolan explained the requirements to host a Kids Fishing Event under the Agreement with Georgia Department of Natural Resources.

Following the discussion, Chair Walker made a motion to approve the Agreement with Georgia Department of Natural Resources for Kids Fishing Event, Vice Chair Holmes seconded. Road Superintendent, Peter Nolan will be responsible for managing the Kids Fishing Event program.. The vote passed unanimously.

Vice Chair Holmes made a motion to go into Executive Session at 9:43 a.m. Chair Walker seconded. The vote passed 3-0-0.

Chair Walker called the meeting back to order at 10:23 a.m.

Personnel issues were discussed in executive session.

No decisions were made.

There being no further business, Vice Chairman Holmes made a motion to adjourn, Commissioner Sparks seconded. The meeting adjourned at 10:25 a.m.
