


**TALBOT COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS & REGISTRATION BOARD MEETING
FEBRUARY 8, 2022**

- A. Call to Order/Moment of Reflection:** Mrs. Trice called the meeting to order at 4:45 p.m. Present were Sharita Trice, Pam Bulloch, Patricia Robinson, and Wycene Willis. Mrs. Robinson said a prayer for our Moment of Reflection.
- B. Agenda Approval:** Mrs. Robinson made a motion to approve the agenda. Wycene seconded and all approved.
- C. Approval of Minutes from December 14, 2021 Meeting:** Wycene made a motion to approve the December minutes. Mrs. Robinson seconded and all approved.
- D. County Elector Reports:** All reports were presented. Mrs. Robinson made a motion to approve all reports. Wycene Willis seconded and all approved.
- E. S.O.S., Firefly, E-Net & Legislative Updates:** We are to continue to be careful when opening e-mails. Effective 3/14/22 the State of Georgia will be launching a new system called GARVIS.
- F. Personnel:** Mrs. Sharita Trice was appointed the new chairperson for Elections for the next four years at the Talbot County Commissioner's Meeting on February 7, 2022. This leaves a vacancy for another board member. Sharita has placed an ad in the Talbotton New Era for a full-time elections assistant position. As of today, one person has applied. The deadline to apply for this position is February 14, 2022.
- G. Upcoming Events:** L & A Testing will begin on February 16, 2022 until completed. We will be using the BMD's and scanners for the March 15, 2022 Special Election for District 1 Board of Education.
There will be a Poll Worker Training on February 22, 2022 at 6:00 p.m.
Early Voting starts on Monday, 2/21/22. There will be two Saturday voting days. Early voting will end on Friday, 3/11/22.
The GAVREO Conference is set for March 20th through 23rd, 2022 in Athens, Georgia. Sharita Trice and Pam Bulloch will be attending the conference.
- H. Training: GARVIS – GeorgiA Voter Registration Information System:** Sharita Trice and Pam Bulloch will go to training in Macon, Georgia on 2/24/22. Gladys Leonard, Patricia Robinson, and Wycene Willis will go to training in Columbus on 3/2/22.
Additional training is needed for staff to use the postage meter. The postage meter has its own Logo for postage, or we can decide if we want our own Logo for postage for Elections. A motion was made by Patricia Robinson that we purchase a Logo for Elections for \$52.00. Pam Bulloch seconded and all approved.
- I. Qualifying:** Qualifying will begin on Monday, 3/7/22 and will end on Friday, 3/11/22 at 12 o'clock noon.
- J. Election Security:** A LED light for the back of our office building is scheduled to be installed. Mrs. Trice will check to see when Flint Energies will do this.
- K. Redistricting:** The deadline for redistricting is February 18, 2022.
- L. Roundtable discussion:** Mrs. Robinson stated how very proud we are to have Sharita Trice as our new Elections Supervisor. She is doing a great job.

M. Adjournment: A motion was made by Wycene Willis not to have a Board Meeting in March because of qualifying, the Special Election, Advance Voting, and the conference in Athens. Mrs. Robinson seconded and all agreed. Our next board meeting will be April 12, 2022. With no further business to discuss Pam Bulloch made a motion to adjourn. Wycene Willis seconded and all approved. The meeting was adjourned at 6:24 p.m.
