


**TALBOT COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS & REGISTRATION BOARD MEETING
JULY 12, 2022**

- A. Call to Order/Moment of Reflection:** Mrs. Trice called the meeting to order at 4:38 p.m. Present were Sharita Trice, Gladys Leonard, Wycene Willis, Salenthia Thomas, and Pam Bulloch. Mrs. Bulloch did our Moment of Reflection.
- B. Approval of Agenda:** Wycene made a motion to approve the agenda. Gladys seconded and all approved.
- C. Approval of Minutes from April 12, 2022 Meeting:** Gladys Leonard made a motion to approve the April 2022 minutes. Wycene Willis seconded and all approved.
- D. County Elector Reports:** All reports were presented. Pam Bulloch made a motion to approve these reports. Wycene seconded and all voted to approve.
- E. S.O.S., Firefly, E-Net & Legislative Updates:** We can process all voter registration in ENet as of last Thursday, 7/7/22.
- F. Overview of General Primary Election and Runoff Election:** There were no changes to be made at this time for conducting the elections. However, for upcoming elections; gate access for poll workers on election night.
- G. Upcoming Events:** Sharita Trice and Salenthia Thomas will be attending L & A Training in Marietta, Georgia on July 20-21, 2022.
- H. City of Talbotton Special Election:** The Talbot County Board of Elections and Registration Office will conduct the special election for the City of Talbotton, Post 3 City Council member. Qualifying will be July 27 - 29th ending at 12 noon on July 29th.
- I. Board of Education:** The Talbot County Board of Elections have agreed to conduct a Special Election for the 1% sales and use tax for education for the Talbot County Board of Education. The Special 1% Tax Question will be on the ballot for the General Election on November 8, 2022.
- J. GARVIS Update:** Elections will begin to phase into GARVIS in February 2023. We will be using E-Net for the November Election and Run-Off. A multi-day training conference for GARVIS is being planned in early 2023 and exact dates are to be determined. We are to continue to check GARVIS daily.
- K. Beta Program-Cellular Poll Pads:** Talbot County is currently on the waiting list for new poll pads. The cellular poll pads will make bulk updates and syncing easier, as well as allocating and reallocating to polling locations.
- L. Roundtable Discussion:** Mrs. Trice has submitted a grant for reimbursement for postage that was used for voter precinct cards that were mailed out after the completion of redistricting.
- M. Adjournment:** Our next board meeting will be Tuesday, August 9, 2022. With no further business to discuss, Pam Bulloch made a motion to adjourn, Gladys Leonard seconded and all approved. The meeting was adjourned at 5:54 p.m.
