


**TALBOT COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS & REGISTRATION BOARD MEETING
OCTOBER 10, 2023**

- A. **Call to Order/Moment of Reflection:** The meeting was called to order at 4:34 p.m. Present were Salenthia Thomas, Dewayne Meacham, Sharita Trice, and Pam Bulloch. Giovante Riggins was our guest, representing Fair Counts. Salenthia Thomas did our Moment of Reflection.
- B. **Approval of Agenda:** Pam Bulloch made a motion to approve the agenda. Salenthia Thomas seconded and all approved.
- C. **Approval of Minutes from September 12, 2023 Meeting:** Salenthia Thomas made a motion to approve the September minutes, Dewayne Meacham seconded and all approved.
- D. **County Elector Reports:** After all reports were presented, Pam Bulloch made a motion to approve, Dewayne Meacham seconded and all voted to approve.
- E. **S.O.S., Firefly, GARViS & Legislative Updates:** Several Georgia counties are having an election in November. Talbot County does not have a November election. New Election Code Books have been sent from the SOS Office. My Voter Page is being updated to make it easier for voters to use.
- F. **GARViS:** We have been using GARViS for several months. Please continue to read the new updates on Continuing the Journey. The last one received was September 29, 2023.
- G. **Upcoming Events:** There will be a Webinar on October 11, 2023, on Poll Pad and ePulse. Two webinars are also scheduled for October 25th and October 31, 2023
- H. **Homeland Security Assessment:** Zac Williams, from Homeland Security visited our office on September 27, 2023. He was very impressed with our building and the security of voting equipment.
- I. **NCOA Mailings:** Mailings were sent out from our office on September 18, 2023. There are ninety seven voters that are on the 50-day clock. If there is no response from these voters, they will automatically become inactive. Our office has received four responses.
- J. **Reminder: Check Email Daily and Voicemail! Voter ID's:** Everyone is continuing to do a great job on checking the email and checking the phone for any voicemail. All staff should complete training on the Voter ID machine to be prepared for anyone needing a Voter ID.
- K. **Cellular Poll Pads Update:** Three poll pad printers and stands were delivered from KnowInk on September 13, 2023. These printers will be used during Advance Voting for the 2024 election cycle.
- L. **Precinct Change:** Mrs. Trice attended the Geneva City Hall meeting on September 12, 2023. The Geneva City Council members voted unanimously to move the Geneva Precinct from Geneva City Hall to the Geneva Volunteer Fire Station. A Public Hearing was held at the Talbot County Elections Office on October 3, 2023 for the public to attend and voice their opinion regarding the Geneva Precinct location move. No one attended to object to this precinct change. Signs will be posted around Geneva and an ad will be put in our local newspaper about this precinct change. Special Precinct Cards will be sent to voters prior to the PPP Election in March 2024.
- M. **GAVREO Conference:** Mrs. Trice has begun our registration to attend the GAVREO Conference in Athens, Georgia, from December 10, 2023 through December 13, 2023.

- N. **Roundtable Discussion:** Mrs. Trice will be working with the county web designer to make changes to our website. There is a part-time position available in our office. To recruit poll workers there will be a poll worker orientation on December 16, 2023. All office staff have been busy scanning voter registration cards. These should be finished in November.
- O. **Adjournment:** With no further business to be discussed, Pam Bulloch made a motion to adjourn, Salenthia Thomas seconded. The meeting was adjourned at 5:48 p.m. Our next scheduled meeting is Tuesday, November 14, 2023.
